And in the said Lodge (when congregated) To admit and make freemasons according to the most Ancient and Honoral of the Royal Craft in all ages and Nations throughout the known world. And we do hereby Impower said Trusty and wellbeloved Brethren Messrs Edward Lane, John Gillet and William Mee (with proper assistants) To nominate, Chose and Install their Successors whom they shall invest with their Power Dignities (and this Warrant) as Masons, and such successors shall in like manner Nominate, Chose and Install their Successors etc etc Such Installations to be upon (or near) every St Johns Day during the continuance of this Lodge for Ever. Providing the above-named Brethren (and their Successors) always pay due respect to this Right Worshipful Grand Lodge otherwise this warrant to be of no force or virtue.

Given under our Hands and the seal of our Grand Lodge in London this Nineteenth day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty and three. And in the year of Masonry Five thousand seven hundred Sixty and three.
